An Act to amend Section 28005 of the Government Code of Guam by correcting the reference section therein relating to grounds for disbarment of attorneys.

*Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:*

Section 1. Section 28005 of Title XXIX, Chapter 1 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 28005. Same: discipline and disbarment.

(a) The committee of examiners of the Judicial Council shall have the authority after hearing to certify to the District Court that any attorney admitted to the practice of law in Guam should be suspended or disbarred from practicing law in Guam. A hearing to determine whether or not such certification should be made to the District Court shall be held by the committee upon the written complaint of any person which alleges a specific violation of one of the subsections of Section 28004 or any act involving moral turpitude.

(b) Upon receiving such a certification the District Court shall take appropriate action to disbar or suspend the attorney from practice or otherwise discipline him."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
