AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 220 of the Government Code of Guam relative to holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 220 of the Government Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 220. LIBERATION DAY. The 21st day of July in each year shall be known as Liberation Day, and is hereby made a legal public holiday in the territory of Guam in commenoration of the anniversary of the liberation of Guam from the enemy on July 21, 1944, and the inauguration of civil government of Guam on July 21, 1950."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.

Approved March 5, 1956.
