Public Law 71--Third Guam Legislature 1956 (SECOND) Regular Session G. L. 184 AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 23001(m) of Title XXIV, Chapter 1 of the Government Code of Guam, relating to the definition of a highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 23001(m) of Title XXIV, Chapter 1, Government Code of Guam is 1 reby amended to read as follows:

"Section 23001(m). A 'highway' is a way or place of whatever nature open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular traffic."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency neasure.
