AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 9318 of the Government Code, relative to the Department of Medical Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 9318 of the Government Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 9318. CERTIFIED COPIES: FEES. Upon request of any person, a certified copy of the records of a birth, death, or marriage, under the control of the office shall be issued upon payment of a fee of fifty cents (\$0.50) for each copy so issued."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
