AN ACT

An Act to amend Subsection 19591.02 of Section 19591 of the Business Privilege Tax Law, Chapter 6, Title XX, Government Code, to provide a new method of computation of the Tobacco Tax with reference to cigars.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Subsection 19591.02 of Section 19591, Chapter 6, Title XX, Government Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

".02. Cigars. Twenty per cent (20%) of the value of all cigars. The term 'value', as used in this subsection, means the landed cost with respect to cigars imported into Guam, and wholesale market value with respect to cigars manufactured or produced in Guam."
