



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT

An Act to add Section 6112.1 to the Government Code establishing an expense and travel fund within the Department of Finance, and amending Section 4110 of the Government Code relating to employees allowances for household effects and auto freights.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 6112.1 is hereby added to the Government Code to read:

"Sec. 6112.1. Expense and Travel Fund - Executive Branch. The Director of Finance shall establish a fund from which all allowable travel and transportation expenses of the employees of the Executive Branch shall be paid. This fund shall be maintained separate and distinct from all other funds of the various agencies and departments of the Executive Branch and shall be administered and maintained under the Director of Finance."

Section 2. Section 4110 of the Government Code is hereby amended to read:

"Sec. 4110. Overseas differential. In the event it is necessary or desirable to recruit officers or employees for the government of Guam from the continental United States or other territory of the United States, the Governor may, on all contracts executed

after July 1, 1951, authorize an overseas pay differential of not to exceed twenty-five (25) per centum of the base rate of pay established for the position or for the class by this chapter. Such pay differential shall be in addition to allowances which may be provided for transportation of the employee, his dependents, and his household and personal effects. Provided, however, that in no case will any allowance which may be provided for transportation as provided herein include an allowance for the expense of freight charges for shipment of automobiles or similar vehicles."
