AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 15000 of the Government Code of Guam to redesignate the present position of Assistant Commissioner in Agana Heights to that of Commissioner and to provide for a Commissioner for Chalan Pago and Ordor, and to provide for an Assistant Commissioner for the Village of Tamuning

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 15000 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 15000. APPORTIONMENT. There shall be a commissioner and/or assistant commissioner for the municipalities and villages of Guam as indicated in the following table:

Section 2. Notwithstanding the effective date of this Act, the Assistant Commissioners of Agana Heights and of Chalan Pago and Ordot shall continue in office for the remaining portion of the term for which they were elected in 1952.

Section 3. The first Commissioners of Agana Heights and of Chalan Pago and Ordot, and the Assistant Commissioner for the Village of Tamuning provided by this Act shall be elected and take office at the same time and in the same manner as other Commissioners provided by law.

Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
