

Public Law 1--Third Guam Legislature  
1956 (SECOND) Special Session

G. L. ?

AN ACT

An Act to appropriate funds for the continuation and/or completion of certain necessary capital and/or interim improvement projects within the territory of Guam and to make certain supplemental appropriations for the operation of the government of Guam, and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the following sums of money for the continuation and completion of certain necessary interim projects as herein set forth:

- A. For interim school construction and collateral equipment as previously authorized and appropriated for by Section 3 (A), Public Law 41, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session, the sum of \$40,000.00
- B. For the purchase of quarters furniture and preparation of new quarters areas as previously authorized and appropriated for by Section 3 (F), Public Law 41, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session, the sum of 27,000.00
- C. To complete the remodeling and rehabilitation of buildings of the Department of Finance as previously authorized and appropriated for by Section 4 (4), Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session, and Section 5 (4), Public Law 7, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session, the sum of 5,000.00

- D. To overhaul and extend the drainage system for Agana by cleaning and deepening the Agana River Channel through the reef to improve the drainage thereof as previously authorized and appropriated for by Section 3 (8), Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session, the sum of \$ 5,000.00
- (E) For interim school construction and maintenance, the sum of 150,000.00

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$11,000.00 for the completion of the construction and purchase of furniture and furnishings of eight staff houses. This appropriation is in addition to the appropriation previously made by Section 5 and Section 6 of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session and Section 2 of Public Law 10, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$10,000.00 for the completion of the construction of an apartment building for the housing of authorized personnel. This appropriation is in addition to the appropriation previously made by Section 3 of Public Law 10, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$91,500.00 for the completion of the construction of a connecting road between Routes 2 and 4 between Agat and Umatac and for the application of two coats of asphalt upon the said road. This appropriation is in addition to the appropriation made by Section 3 (3) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of

\$452,000.00 for the continuation of the construction of the Guam Memorial Hospital.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$1,200,000.00 for the continuation of construction of permanent reinforced concrete school plants and equipment therefor as previously authorized and appropriated for by Section 6, Public Law 41, Third Guam Legislature 1955 (First) Regular Session. \$600,000.00 of this appropriation shall be made available immediately and the remaining \$600,000.00 of this appropriation shall be made available July 1, 1956.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$22,000.00 for the use of the Housing Revolving Fund to augment the appropriation previously made by Section 5 of Public Law 2, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Second) Special Session.

Section 8. The sum of \$51,000.00 appropriated for the George Washington High School Cafeteria by Subsection B of Section 3, Public Law 41, Third Guam Legislature, (First) Regular Session, is hereby reappropriated and shall be used to establish and equip a cafeteria or cafeterias in such school building or buildings as required by Federal specifications and as may be selected by the Director of Education. The additional sum of \$26,000.00 is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated and shall likewise be used for establishing and equipping a cafeteria or cafeterias in such school building or buildings as may be selected by the Director of Education.

Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$50,000.00 to be used for the installation, construction, and extension of water distribution lines and facilities to and within the Malojlo area of Inarajan.

Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$75,000.00 to be used for the installation, con-

struction, and extension of electrical power transmission and distribution lines and facilities to and within Merizo and Umatac.

Section 11. There is hereby reappropriated from the appropriation made by Subsection K of Section 3, Public Law No. 41, Third Guam Legislature, 1955 (First) Regular Session, the sum of \$45,000.00, which sum shall be used for the installation, construction, and extension of water distribution lines and facilities to and within the Tumon and Ypao areas. The unexpended balance of the appropriation made by Subsection (18) of Section 3, Public Law No. 1, Second Guam Legislature, 1954 (Third) Special Session, is likewise hereby reappropriated and shall be used for the installation, construction, and extension of water distribution lines and facilities to and within the Tumon and Ypao areas.

Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$200,000.00, which sum shall be used to pay for privately owned lands acquired by the government of Guam and to pay rentals on privately owned lands leased by the government of Guam.

Section 13. The Public Utility Agency is hereby authorized to make from any unencumbered moneys in the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund the following capital investments:

- (a) For improvement of the water distribution system in Barrigada and extension of water lines and facilities to serve customers along Route 8 between Barrigada and the Canada Road, the sum of \$25,000.00.
- (b) For improvement of telephone lines, facilities, and service in the general area of Guam Memorial Hospital, the sum of \$15,000.00.

- (c) For relocation of the power sub-station from Tamuning to a location near the new Guam Memorial Hospital, the sum of \$15,000.00.

Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the purpose of supplementing the appropriations made for the operations of the named departments for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956.

Department of Education	\$ 82,000.00
Civil Defense Agency	3,000.00

Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$133,000.00 to supplement the appropriations for the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956.

Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$50,000.00 to be used as follows:

- (a) For the relocation of administrative activities of the Department of Agriculture and the construction of a suitable building for such activities, the sum of \$35,000.00.
- (b) For the relocation of the warehousing activities of the Department of Agriculture and the construction of a suitable building and all incidental facilities therefore, including but not limited to parking area, provisions for access, and excavation, the sum of \$15,000.00.

Section 17. Appropriations heretofore made for certain capital improvement projects having proved insufficient for completion of such projects, the costs of such projects having exceeded the amounts appropriated, there are hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated such sums for such projects as are hereinafter stated, to supply the deficiencies in the prior appropriations for such projects:

- (a) For a school building and necessary facilities and equipment required in connection therewith, for housing the George Washington High School as authorized by Section 2 (c) and Section 4 (3) of Public Law 29, First Guam Legislature, First Regular Session; Section 3 (f) of Public Law 64, First Guam Legislature, Second Regular Session; and Section 3 (c) of Public Law 49, Second Guam Legislature, First Regular Session, the sum of \$14,296.49.
- (b) For planning, construction and acquisition of necessary land, for three elementary school structures and the completion of a fourth as authorized by Section 3 (c) of Public Law 64, First Guam Legislature, Second Regular Session and Section 9 of Public Law 49, Second Guam Legislature, First Regular Session, the sum of \$945.37.
- (c) For the rehabilitation of the former Bank of America Building as authorized by Section 4 (3) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$1,583.67.
- (d) For the rehabilitation of the Department of Finance Building including the addition of a porch and additional office

space, as authorized by Section 4 (4) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$404.84.

- (e) For the remodeling of the Department of Education Administration Building for office space, classrooms and necessary collateral facilities and equipment therefor as authorized by Section 3 (36) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$4,253.65.
- (f) For the remodeling and rehabilitation of the George Washington High School Auditorium including re-roofing and installation of shower rooms and toilet facilities as authorized by Section 3 (37) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$433.31.
- (g) For the improvement of roads and further construction of pavements and concrete steps within the George Washington High School area, as authorized by Section 3 (38) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$4,254.37.
- (h) For the addition, relocation, or remodeling of classrooms at Barrigada School and for the purchase of necessary facilities and collateral equipment therefor as authorized by Section 3 (32) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$232.63.

- (i) For the remodeling of the laboratory and biology building of the George Washington High School and the provision of necessary facilities and collateral equipment therefor as authorized by Section 3 (33) of Public Law 1, Second Guam Legislature, Third Special Session, the sum of \$1,209.42.
- (j) For the Farm Advisors' project, funds for which were included in the appropriation made by Item I of Section 1 of Public Law 55, First Guam Legislature, Second Regular Session, the sum of \$7,503.64.
- (k) For TB Ward improvements, funds for which were included in the appropriation made by Item A of Section 1 of Public Law 55, First Guam Legislature, Second Regular Session, the sum of \$3,424.22.

Section 18. There are hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the construction, installation and extension of electrical power transmission and distribution lines and facilities to and within the following areas:

(a) Canada and Leyang	\$ 50,000.00
(b) Chalan Pago (Mairai and Cogna, both sides of the road)	15,000.00
(c) Yona	7,000.00
(d) Agat	7,000.00



Section 19. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase and preparation of site and construction of a permanent elementary school at Tamuning, the sum of \$400,000.00.

Section 20. There are hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the installation, construction and extension of water distribution lines and facilities to and within the following areas:

(a) Yigo	\$ 60,000.00
(b) Chalan Pago (Maimai and Cogna)	25,000.00
(c) Yona	20,000.00
(d) Agana Heights	18,000.00
(e) Barrigada Heights	2,000.00
(f) Ordot area	8,000.00

Section 21. There are hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the development, construction or improvement of recreation centers, including appropriate facilities, within the following areas:

(a) Umatac	\$ 3,000.00
(b) Yona	4,000.00
(c) Mangilao	3,000.00
(d) Toto	3,000.00
(e) Sinajana	10,000.00

Section 22. There are hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated the following sums of money to improve the streets in the following areas by application of two coats of asphalt upon said streets:

(a) Santa Rita	\$ 20,000.00
(b) Sinajana	30,000.00

Section 23. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, for the widening and asphalt paving of streets in the village of Dededo, the sum of \$20,000.00.

Section 24. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, for the installation of a drainage system in the Old Agat area, the sum of \$5,000.00.

Section 25. Upon completion of any utility project provided for in this Act, any unexpended balance of the sum appropriated for such project shall be available for reallocation to any uncompleted projects provided for in this Act.

Section 26. Every appropriation made herein shall be available for expenses incident to the project for which the appropriation is made including the expenses of administration, planning, supervision, and other similar expenses. Each appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed, except where otherwise stated in this Act.

Section 27. This is an urgency measure.
