

5 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 14300 OF THE GOVERNMENT
6 CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO INSPECTION AND SEALING
7 OF WEIGHING AND MEASURING DEVICES, AND TO ADD
8 SECTION 14300.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
9 AUTHORIZING INSPECTION OF WEIGHING AND MEASURING
10 DEVICES AND TO AMEND SECTION 14303 OF THE GOVERN-
11 MENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE FEES CHARGED
12 FOR INSPECTING AND SEALING OF WEIGHING AND
13 MEASURING DEVICES.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

15 Section 1. Section 14300 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 14300. Inspection and seals. The Director
17 of Commerce shall annually, or oftener in his discretion,
18 cause all devices or appliances used for the ascertainment
19 of weight, length or measure in connection with buying or
20 selling, or with transportation or receiving for shipment,
21 or of any commodity offered for sale or to be offered for
22 sale, or for any other commercial purpose, to be inspected,
23 proved as to accuracy and sealed."

24 Section 2. Section 14300.1 is hereby added to the Government
25 Code of Guam to read as follows:

26 "Section 14300.1. Exhibition for inspection. Every
27 merchant, corporation, or person using or having on his
28 premise, a device or appliance for use in the ascertain-
29 ment of weight, length or measure in connection with
30 buying or selling, or with transportation or receiving
31 for shipment, or of any commodity offered for sale or
32 to be offered for sale, or for any other commercial
purpose, shall exhibit the same to the Director of
Commerce or his designated representative upon his
request for inspection and examination. Any merchant,
person or officer of a corporation who neglects or refuses
to exhibit such weighing or measuring device or appliance

1 after the exhibition has been requested of him shall be
2 guilty of a misdemeanor."

3 Section 3. Section 14303 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 14303. Fees. The Director of Commerce shall
6 collect for each annual inspection of a scale, weight, or
7 measure before sealing the same and delivering to the
8 owner thereof a certificate of its accuracy, the following
9 fees:

10 For Scales:

- 11 (a) From one to thirty pounds
12 weight capacity \$0.50
- 13 (b) Over thirty pounds to one
14 hundred pounds weight capacity .75
- 15 (c) Over one hundred pounds to five
16 hundred pounds weight capacity 1.00
- 17 (d) Over five hundred pounds to two
18 thousand pounds weight capacity 1.50
- 19 (e) Over two thousand pounds to five
20 thousand pounds weight capacity 2.00
- 21 (f) Over five thousand pounds to ten
22 thousand pounds weight capacity 2.50
- 23 (g) Over ten thousand pounds weight
24 capacity 3.00

25 For Dry or Liquid Measures:

- 26 (a) Dry or liquid measure of less
27 than one gallon capacity .50
- 28 (b) Dry or liquid measure of more
29 than one gallon capacity .75
- 30 (c) Pump or pumping measure or
31 appliance 1.00

The Director of Commerce shall pay over to the Treasurer of Guam for deposit in the general fund of the Treasury of Guam, all fees collected pursuant to this section."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take effect at 12:01 A. M. on the tenth day following approval thereof by the Governor.
