AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21300.13 AND TO ADD SECTION 21300.14 TO CHAPTER 4. TITLE XXII. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR THE APPLICATION OF PENALTIES PROVIDED BY SECTION 21300.13.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 21300.13 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 21300.13. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation furnishing public transportation service on the highways of Guam, except the operation of taxicabs regulated under the provisions of Chapter 2. Title XXII. Government Code of Guam, and Chapter 5, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, not having a valid franchise pursuant to this Chapter shall, upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment of not less than 30 days nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment." Section 2. Section 21300.14 is hereby added to Chapter 4, Title XXII, Government Code of Guam, as follows:

> "Section 21300.14. Enforcement Date. The penalty provision under Section 21300.13 shall apply only where a franchise has been granted." Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
