5 AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRI-
6 ATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE GOVERN-
7 MENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
8 ENDING JUNE 30, 1959, AND FOR OTHER
9 PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any
12 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the
13 Government of Guam to supplement appropriation made by Public Law 72,
14 Fourth Guam Legislature, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959:

- 15 A. For operation of the Department of Medical
16 Services \$ 155,000
- 17 B. For operation of the Department of
18 Public Works 25,000
- 19 C. For allowable travel and transportation
20 expenses of the Executive Branch of the
21 Government of Guam 135,000

22 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in
23 the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam the
24 sum of \$30,000 for the Scholarship and Student Loan Fund.

25 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
