2 Substitute bill by Committee on  
3 Finance and Taxation

4 AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR  
5 CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND  
6 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
9 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam,  
10 not heretofore appropriated, the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00)  
11 for the Department of Agriculture for the purchase of cattle breeding stock.

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in  
13 the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, not  
14 heretofore appropriated, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the  
15 construction of permanent public health centers with matching funds from the  
16 Federal Government under the Hill-Burton Act.

17 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in  
18 the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, not  
19 heretofore appropriated, the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the  
20 purchase of textbooks to be furnished students in private schools, as authorized  
21 by Section 11205 of the Government Code of Guam.

22 Section 4. Every appropriation made herein shall be available for all  
23 expenses incident to the purpose for which made, and continue in full force and  
24 effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appro-  
25 priation is made or until the project is completed, with the exception of the  
26 appropriation made in Section 1 hereof which shall be available only until June 30,  
27 1959.

28 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
