Substitute bill by Committee on Finance and Taxation

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, not heretofore appropriated, the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for the Department of Agriculture for the purchase of cattle breeding stock.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, not heretofore appropriated, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the construction of permanent public health centers with matching funds from the Federal Government under the Hill-Burton Act.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, not heretofore appropriated, the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of textbooks to be furnished students in private schools, as authorized by Section 11205 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 4. Every appropriation made herein shall be available for all expenses incident to the purpose for which made, and continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed, with the exception of the appropriation made in Section 1 hereof which shall be available only until June 30, 1959.

Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
