FIFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE 1959 (FIRST) Regular Session Bill No. 27 Introduced by_ Committee on Judiciary, by request AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23362(b) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN RELATIVE TO DELINQUENT PENALTIES FOR AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION. BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 23362(b) of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 23362(b). If any fee becomes delinquent, a penalty shall be added thereto in the amount of twenty-five per cent (25%) of the fee payable for each quarter or fraction thereof the fee is delinquent. Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
