7 TO DELINQUENT PENALTIES FOR AUTOMOBILE

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Section 23362(b) of the Government Code of Guam
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 23362(b). If any fee becomes delinquent, a
13 penalty shall be added thereto in the amount of twenty-five
14 per cent (25%) of the fee payable for each quarter or fraction
15 thereof the fee is delinquent.

16 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
