4 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13600 OF THE
5 GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO LAND
6 USE PERMITS.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. Section 13600 of the Government Code of Guam is
9 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "Section 13600. Use Permits. (a) The Director is
11 authorized to grant permits for the temporary use of any suit-
12 able government real property, not otherwise occupied or in
13 use, for agricultural purposes, including grazing.

14 (b) Such permits shall be granted for a period not
15 exceeding five (5) years.

16 (c) No person shall use or occupy under any such permit
17 more than fifty hectares for grazing or more than ten hectares
18 for any other agricultural purpose.

19 (d) The Department shall collect a reasonable charge
20 from each permit-holder, based upon the value of the land and
21 the use made thereof.

22 (e) The form of such permits shall be prescribed by the
23 Attorney General.

24 (f) The Director, with the approval of the Governor, shall
25 make such reasonable rules, not inconsistent with the foregoing
26 provisions of this section, governing the qualifications for,
27 applications for and issuance of such permits, the terms and
28 conditions thereof, the charges to be collected therefor, super-
29 vision of operations thereunder, and enforcement of the terms
30 thereof as may be necessary or desirable to the efficient adminis-
31 tration of the program and in the public interest.

32 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
