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4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13600 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO LAND	
5	USE PERMITS.	
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:	
7	Section 1. Section 13600 of the Government Code of Guam is	
8	hereby amended to read as follows:	
9	"Section 13600. Use Permits. (a) The Director is	
10	authorized to grant permits for the temporary use of any suit-	
11	able government real property, not otherwise occupied or in	
12	use, for agricultural purposes, including grazing,	
13	(b) Such permits shall be granted for a period not	
14	exceeding five (5) years,	
15	(c) No person shall use or occupy under any such permit	
16	more than fifty hectares for grazing or more than ten hectares	
17	for any other agricultural purpose.	
18	(d) The Department shall collect a reasonable charge	
19	from each permit-holder, based upon the value of the land and	
20	the use made thereof.	
21	(e) The form of such permits shall be prescribed by the	
22	Attorney General.	
23	(f) The Director, with the approval of the Governor, shall	
24	make such reasonable rules, not inconsistent with the foregoing	
25	provisions of this section, governing the qualifications for,	
26	applications for and issuance of such permits, the terms and	
27	conditions thereof, the charges to be collected therefor, super-	
28	vision of operations thereunder, and enforcement of the terms	
29	thereof as may be mecessary or desirable to the efficient adminis-	
30	tration of the program and in the public interest.	
31	Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.	
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
