8	Section 1. Section 121 of the Code of Civil Procedure of Guam is
9	hereby amended to read as follows:
10	"Section 121. Composition. There shall be a Judicial
11	Council of Guam, which shall consist of the Judge of the District
12	Court of Guam, who shall be chairman, the chief judge and
13	judges of the Island Court and the Judge of the Police Court,
14	the chairman of the Committee on Judiciary of the Legislature,
15	or his duly authorized representative, the Attorney General of
16	Guam, or his duly authorized representative, and the president
17	of the Bar Association of Guam, or his duly authorized repre-
1 8	sentative. The concurrence of four shall be necessary to any
19	action taken by the Judicial Council. The Judicial Council may
20	elect a vice-chairman from among its membership and a
21	secretary who shall not be a member of the Judicial Council.
22	No member or officer of the Judicial Council, except the
23	secretary, shall receive any compensation as such."
24	Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
