

5 **AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23407(a) OF THE**
6 **GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO**
7 **RECKLESS DRIVING AND PROVIDING FOR THE**
8 **PUNISHMENT THEREOF.**

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:**

10 **Section 1. Section 23407(a) of the Government Code of Guam**
11 **is hereby amended to read as follows:**

12 " (a) Every person who drives any vehicle upon a highway
13 in wilful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or
14 property is guilty of reckless driving which is a misdemeanor.
15 Every person convicted under this section shall be punished
16 upon a first conviction by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor
17 more than \$250.00 or by imprisonment of not more than six
18 months or by both such fine and imprisonment, and upon a
19 second or any subsequent conviction of the violation of this
20 section within a period of five years of the date of commission
21 of the first offense by imprisonment of not less than five days
22 nor more than six months and by a fine of not less than \$250.00
23 nor more than \$1,000.00, except as provided in subdivision (b)
24 of this section."

25 **Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.**
