AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23407(a) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO RECKLESS DRIVING AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1, Section 23407(a) of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) Every person who drives any vehicle upon a highway in wilful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property is guilty of reckless driving which is a misdemeanor. Every person convicted under this section shall be punished upon a first conviction by a fine of not less than \$25,00 mor more than \$250,00 or by imprisonment of not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment, and upon a second or any subsequent conviction of the violation of this section within a period of five years of the date of commission of the first offense by imprisonment of not less than five days nor more than six months and by a fine of not less than \$250,00 nor more than \$1,000,00, except as provided in subdivision (b) of this section."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
