AN ACT TO COMBINE AND REAPPROPRIATE UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF PREVIOUS APPROPRIATIONS FOR RECREATION AREAS, PLAYGROUND SITES AND FACILITIES. AND 6 CIVIC CENTERS. BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 8 Section 1. The unexpended balance of appropriations made by 9 Section 3(1), Public Law 64, First Guam Legislature, 10 Section 3(i), Public Law 49, Second Guam Legislature. 11 Section 21, Public Law 1, Third Guam Legislature, Second Special 12 Session, with the exception of the appropriations made 13 therein in Sub-Section (a), 14 Section 11, Public Law 112, Third Guam Legislature, 15 Section 2, Public Law 114, Third Guam Legislature, with the 16 exception of the appropriations made therein for the 17 villages of Piti, Asan, Mangilao, 18 Section 1H, Public Law 47, Fourth Guam Legislature, 19 Section 8(b), Public Law 78, Fourth Guam Legislature, 20 Section 8(c), Public Law 73, Fourth Guam Legislature, 21 are hereby reappropriated for the purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping 22 recreation areas, including playgrounds and civic centers, as needed or desirable 23 throughout Guam . 24 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall be 25 available for all expenses incident to the locality for which made wherever 26 practical, and shall continue in full force and effect and remain available until 27 expended for such purpose or such other purposes as the Recreation Commission 28 may determine. 29 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
