

4 AN ACT TO COMBINE AND REAPPROPRIATE
5 UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF PREVIOUS
6 APPROPRIATIONS FOR RECREATION AREAS,
7 PLAYGROUND SITES AND FACILITIES, AND
8 CIVIC CENTERS.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. The unexpended balance of appropriations made by

11 Section 3(1), Public Law 64, First Guam Legislature,

12 Section 3(1), Public Law 49, Second Guam Legislature,

13 Section 21, Public Law 1, Third Guam Legislature, Second Special

14 Session, with the exception of the appropriations made

15 therein in Sub-Section (a),

16 Section 11, Public Law 112, Third Guam Legislature,

17 Section 2, Public Law 114, Third Guam Legislature, with the

18 exception of the appropriations made therein for the

19 villages of Piti, Asan, Mangilao,

20 Section 1H, Public Law 47, Fourth Guam Legislature,

21 Section 8(b), Public Law 73, Fourth Guam Legislature,

22 Section 8(c), Public Law 73, Fourth Guam Legislature,

23 are hereby reappropriated for the purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping
24 recreation areas, including playgrounds and civic centers, as needed or desirable
25 throughout Guam.

26 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall be
27 available for all expenses incident to the locality for which made wherever
28 practical, and shall continue in full force and effect and remain available until
29 expended for such purpose or such other purposes as the Recreation Commission
30 may determine.

31 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
