Public Law 5-28 Fifth Guam Legislature 1959 (FIRST) Special Session G. L. 120(1-S)

AN ACT

An Act making appropriations for the operation of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. The following sums are appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund, not heretofore appropriated, for the operation of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960:

Section 3. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed ten per cent (10%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or items of the appropriation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote efficiency and economy of operation of the Executive Branch of the government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration of any function or program from one department to another of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of funds allocated to such function or program, notwithstanding the amount so transferred is in excess of ten percent (10%) of the total amount appropriated for either such department.

Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.

It is declared to be the intent and policy of the Government of Guam that whenever available or attainable, the most economical first-class transportation accommodation shall be utilized for transportation of off-island employees of the Government of Guam from and to point of hire.

Section 3. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed tem per cent (10%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or items of the appropriation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote efficiency and economy of operation of the Executive Branch of the government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration of any function or program from one department to another of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of funds allocated to such function or program, notwithstanding the amount so transferred is in excess of ten percent (10%) of the total amount appropriated for either such department.
