4 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12009, AND TO
5 REPEAL SECTION 12010, OF CHAPTER 1,
6 TITLE XIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,
7 RELATIVE TO THE AGRICULTURAL REVOLVING
8 FUND.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. Section 12009, Chapter 1, Title XIII, Government
9 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "Section 12009. Authority to receive monies.

11 The Department is authorized to receive monies derived
12 from all fees provided under this Title, from the sale
13 and rental of equipment, and from the sale of livestock,
14 produce, fertilizers, plants, seeds and pesticides.

15 Such monies shall be promptly transmitted to the
16 Treasurer of Guam, together with an accounting of
17 the source from which such monies are derived, and
18 deposited in the General Fund."

19 Section 2. Section 12010, Chapter 1, Title XIII, Government
20 Code of Guam, is hereby repealed.

21 Section 3. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1959.
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
