AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12009, AND TO REPEAL SECTION 12010, OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE XIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, BELATIVE TO THE AGRICULTURAL REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 12009, Chapter 1, Title XIII, Government
Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 12009. Authority to receive monies.

The Department is authorized to receive monies derived from all fees provided under this Title, from the sale and rental of equipment, and from the sale of livestock, produce, fertilizers, plants, seeds and pesticides.

Such menies shall be promptly transmitted to the Treasurer of Guam, together with an accounting of the source from which such menies are derived, and deposited in the General Fund."

Section 2. Section 12010, Chapter 1, Title XIII, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1959.
