5 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 42015 AND 42017,  
6 AND TO REPEAL SECTION 42016, GOVERNMENT  
7 CODE OF GUAM, CONCERNING THE GUAM PUBLIC  
8 LIBRARY.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Section 42015, of Chapter 1, Title XXXVIII,  
11 Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

12 "Section 42015. Gifts. The Board shall have  
13 authority to accept on behalf of, and in the name of, the  
14 government of Guam, from any government or agency there-  
15 of, or any person, advisory services, grants-in-aid, and  
16 gifts and donations of money and other property for the  
17 benefit of the Library; provided that any grant-in-aid,  
18 gift, donation or other form of assistance involving  
19 an obligation on the part of the Library or the govern-  
20 ment of Guam shall require the approval of the Governor."

21 Section 2. Section 42016, of Chapter 1, Title XXXVIII,  
22 Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed.

23 Section 3. Section 42017, of Chapter 1, Title XXXVIII,  
24 Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 42017. Custody of Funds. All monies of  
26 the Library, coming under Section 42015, and any  
27 deposits by borrowers, shall be kept in the custody  
28 of the Treasurer of Guam, and disbursed under authority  
29 of the Board."

30 Section 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1959.
