BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN: Section 1. Section 42015, of Chapter 1. Title XXXVIII. Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

> "Section 42015. Gifts. The Board shall have authority to accept on behalf of, and in the name of, the government of Guam, from any government or agency thereof, or any person, advisory services, grants-in-mid, and gifts and donations of money and other property for the benefit of the Library; provided that any grant-in-sid, gift, donation or other form of assistance involving an obligation on the part of the Library or the government of Guam shall require the approval of the Governor." Section 2. Section 42016, of Chapter 1, Title XXXVIII,

Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Section 42017, of Chapter 1, Title XXXVIII. Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 42017. Custody of Funds. All monies of the Library, coming under Section 42015, and any deposits by berrowers, shall be kept in the custody of the Treasurer of Guam, and disbursed under authority of the Board."

Section 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1959.
