AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 10 TO TITLE K. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN: Section 1. Chapter 10 is hereby added to Title X. Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 10

PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

Section 9925. Designation of the Department of Medical Services as cooperative agency. The Department of Medical Services is hereby designated as the agency to cooperate with the United States Public Health Service in the administration of those parts of the Public Health Service Act, as amended, which relate to grants and services for public health purposes, and is authorized to apply for, receive and expend all funds made available by the Federal Government, or from any other source for the purposes provided in this Chapter.

Section 9925.1. Public Health Services Programs: Administration: Purposes.

(1) The Department of Medical Services is hereby designated as the agency to administer public health services programs in Guam.

(2) The purpose of such programs shall be to develop. extend and improve public health services.

Section 9925.2. Guam plan fer public health services.

(1) The Department of Medical Services is hereby empowered and authorized:

(a) To formulate, adopt, subject to the approval

of the Governor, and administer a detailed plan or plans for the purposes specified in Section 9925.1.

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(b) To make and adopt all such rules and regulations, subject to the approval of the Governor, not inconsistent with the provisions of Sections 9925.1 to 9925.5, inclusive, or of the Public Health Services Act, as are or may be necessary for the administration of this Chapter.

(2) Such plan or plans and the rules and regulations when formulated shall be submitted to the Surgeon General of the United States Public Health Service, and when approved by him shall thereupon be made effective by the Department of Medical Services for the purposes of this Chapter.

Section 9925.3. Provisions to be included in Guam plan. Such plan or plans shall include therein provisions for:

(1) Financial participation by Guam.

(2) Administration of such plan or plans by the Department of Medical Services.

(3) Such methods of sciministration as are necessary for efficient operation of such plan or plans.

(4) Maintenance of records and preparation, submission and filing of reports of services rendered.

(5) Cooperation with medical, health, nursing and welfare groups and organizations for the purpose of extending and improving public health services.

(6) Receiving and expending in the menner provided herein in accordance with such plan or plans, all funds made available by the Federal Government or from any other source for such purposes.

(7) Cooperating with the Federal Government, through its appropriate agency or instrumentality. in developing,

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extending and improving such services, and in the administration of such plan or plans.

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(8) Carrying out the purposes specified in Section 9925.1.

Section 9925.4. Duties of Director of Medical Services.

(1) The Director of Medical Services shall be the administrative officer of the agency with respect to the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this Chapter, and of the plan or plans formulated and adopted in accordance therewith and all such rules and regulations necessary thereto.

(2) The Director of Medical Services is hereby empowered and directed to administer and enforce all rules and regulations adopted for the efficient operations of the plan or plans formulated for the purposes of this Chapter.

(3) The Director of Medical Services shall, from time to time as directed by the Surgeon General, make such reports, in such form and containing such information as the Surgeon General shall require.

(4) The Director of Medical Services shall from time to time, pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Surgeon General, requisition and cause to be deposited with the Treasurer of Guam all moneys allotted to Guam by the Federal Government for the purposes of this Chapter, and shall cause to be paid out of the treasury the moneys there is deposited for such purposes.

Section 9925.5. Public Realth Service Funds: Custody: Expenditures.

(1) The Treasurer of Guam is hereby made custodian of all moneys allotted to Guam by the Federal Government, or received from other sources, for the purposes of public health services.

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(2) The Treasurer of Guan shall receive and provide for the proper custody of such moneys and is authorized to deposit such moneys in the same manner as other public moneys are deposited.

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(3) Such moneys shall be disbursed only upon certification by the Director of Medical Services."
