
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 33, TITLE II,
PART I, OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM, IN
REFERENCE TO THE PUNISHMENT OF ACCES-
SORIES TO CRIMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 33 of the Penal Code of Guam is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 33. Punishment of accessories. Except
in cases where a different punishment is prescribed
by law, an accessory is punishable by imprisonment not
exceeding five years, or by a fine not exceeding one
thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine
and imprisonment."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
