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
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



Introduced by J. L. Anderson

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION 1 OF SECTION
690 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE OF
GUAM RELATING TO THE EXEMPTION VALUES
OF A DEBTOR'S DWELLING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection 1 of Section 690 of the Code of
Civil Procedure of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. The dwelling house in which the judgment
debtor resides and the land on which same is
situated, not exceeding in values, \$3,000 for the
head of a family or \$2,000 for any other person."
