
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

**AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1960, AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from
3 any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund,
4 of the government of Guam for the operation of the Executive Branch
5 of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960,
6 and are hereby added to appropriations made by Section 1 of Public
7 Law 5-26:

8	Department of Finance	\$55,044.00
9	Budget and Management Office	43,242.00
10	Department of Public Safety	17,940.00
11	Department of Public Works	13,650.00
12	Department of Medical Services	64,506.00
13	Department of Education	43,000.00

16 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
17 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the govern-
18 ment of Guam the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00)
19 for the government's contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement
20 Fund.

21 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the govern-
23 ment of Guam the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars
24 (\$250,000.00) for allowable travel and transportation expenses of the
25 Executive Branch of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ending

June 30, 1960.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the Workmen's Compensation Fund established by Section 37042 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) for a survey by a private organization of the personnel law and its operation, including consideration of such other allied items as compensation, employment problems, and the like. The funds appropriated by this Section shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.

Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.
