AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 25312 AND 25314
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND
THE CLOSING TIME FOR PREMISES LICENSED
FOR ON-SALE AND OFF-SALE LIQUOR SALES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 25312 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 25312. Hours of sale. On-sale premises.
5 An on-sale licensee shall not sell or serve any person
6 any alcoholic beverages after 1:00 a.m., except that as
7 to the day preceding New Year's Day, the selling time
8 shall be 2:00 a.m. January 1st. [Provided, however, that
9 all alcoholic beverages must be consumed within 15 minutes
10 of the time permitted for the sale thereof. A licensee
11 may begin selling or serving alcoholic beverages at
12 9:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday inclusive and at 10:00 a.m.
13 Sunday."

14 Section 2. Section 25314 of the Government Code of Guam is
15 hereby amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 25314. Same: Off-sale. An off-sale
17 licensee shall not sell alcoholic beverages prior to,
18 10:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m. on Sunday nor prior
19 to 9:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday
20 inclusive."

21 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
