BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Six Hundred Ferty-Two Dollars 4\$125,642.00 is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam, not otherwise appropriated, for the contingent expenses of the Judicial Branch, government of Guam, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.
