AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1960, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUARIT

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Dellars (\$147,000) for the operation and contingent expenses of the Legislative Branch of the government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any evailable funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guan the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for an outside independent sudit of the books of the government for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1959, to be conducted under the general direction of the Executive and Legislative Branches of the government.
