AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE OPERATION OF SECTION 1015. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR, DURING THE REMAINDER OF THE CALENDAR YEAR 1960. AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE FOR THE CONVENING OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE DURING THE YEAR 1960.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1015 of the Government Code of Gusm is hereby suspended and declared inoperative during the remainder of the calendar year 1960, and the annual regular session of the Gusm Legis-lature during the year 1960 shall be held as follows:

- (a) Convening upon the second Monday of January, 1960, the Legislature shall remain in session for one day and at the conclusion thereof adjourn to the first day of February, 1960, on which date it shall reconvene at the hour of two o'clock p.m., and shall remain in session twenty-mine consecutive calendar days, and at the conclusion thereof adjourn to the second Monday of July, 1960;
- (b) Reconvening on the second Monday of July, 1960, at the bour of two o'clock p.m., the Legislature shall thereupon remain in session thirty consecutive calendar days.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 1961, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be and become inoperative and thereupon the provisions of Section 1015 of the Government Code of Guam shall be and remain in full force and effect; and themseforth all annual regular sessions of the Guam Legislature shall be held in accordance with and agreeably to the provisions of said Section 1015 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section S. This Act is an urgency measure.
