AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17050.1 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO ADD A
NEW SECTION 17108 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ZONING REGULATIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 17050.1 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 17050.1. Zoning Map: Agana: Adopted.

5 The map attached hereto entitled 'Zoning Map Part 1 - Agana,'
6 as identified by drawing number GI-54517, as amended, is hereby
7 adopted as a part of the 'Zoning Map'. Such attached map and
8 all the notations, references and other information shown shall
9 be as much a part of this law as if the matters and information
10 set forth by said map were all fully described herein."

11 Section 2. A new Section 17108 is hereby added to the
12 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

13 "Section 17108. 'LC' limited commercial zone.

14 (a) Uses permitted.

- 15 1. Personal service shops, including barber
16 shops, beauty parlors, and the like; provided,
17 that such personal services are carried on
18 exclusively within a family dwelling."

19 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
