**AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 6115 TO CHAPTER 2,
TITLE VII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,
RELATING TO CONTRACTS AND PURCHASE ORDERS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

**Section 1. Section 6115 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
Title VII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:**

"Section 6115. Contracts and purchase orders.

**Whenever appropriations have been made for any fiscal year,
contracts and purchase orders may be executed and charged
against such appropriations at any time prior to the
beginning of the fiscal year; provided, however, that no
payments shall be made pursuant to such contracts or
purchase orders prior to the fiscal year for which such
appropriations are made."**

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
