
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS, EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 1960, FOR NECESSARY CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the following
4 sums for the purposes and projects set forth:

5 (a) For the continuation of the highways
6 and pavements construction program \$382,997.00

7 (b) For the purchase of automotive
8 equipment for the Executive Branch of the
9 Government of Guam 50,000.00

10 Section 2. The sum of \$16,000.00 is hereby appropriated from
11 any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund for
12 matching funds for the Geological Survey.

13 Section 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall be
14 effective July 1, 1960, and shall be available for all expenses incident
15 to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall
16 continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended
17 for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project
18 is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this Act
19 may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled
20 personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appro-
21 priations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as
22 authorized by the Governor, and may include the furnishing of travel,
23 transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of
24 Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by
25 the Governor.

26 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS, EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
1960, FOR NECESSARY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PRO-
JECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the following sums for the purposes and projects set forth:

(a) For the continuation of the highways
and pavements construction program \$382,997.00

(b) For the purchase of automotive
equipment for the Executive Branch of the
Government of Guam 50,000.00

Section 2. The sum of \$16,000.00 is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund for matching funds for the Geological Survey.

Section 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective July 1, 1960, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this Act may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor, and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.

Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
