**AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR
RECLAMATION OF THE AGANA SWAMP AND
LAND FILL ON THE PASEO DE SUSANA.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000.00 to the Department of Public Works for reclamation by Government of Guam personnel and equipment of Government owned land in the Agana Swamp and land fill on the Paseo de Susana.

Section 2. The appropriation made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Such appropriation shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the capital improvement projects for which the appropriation is made or until the projects are completed.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
