AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following sums for the purposes set forth herein:

(a) To construct the second increment of the Administration Building:	\$100,000.00
(b) To the Special Low Cost Housing Reserve of the Guarantee Fund of the Guam Finance and Development Administration:	150,000.00
(c) To provide sanitary facilities for Public Health Centers:	3,000.00
(d) To complete construction of the Territorial College:	34,000.00
(e) For alteration and improvements to temporary school buildings:	75,000.00
(f) For payment of rentals on privately owned lands leased by the Government:	72,668.00
(g) For permanent school construction:	47,000.00
(i) For the purposes of village public works:	20,000.00
(k) For the parks and monuments program, to be added to the amount appropriated in Section 1(d) of Public Law 5-58:	5,000.00

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$19,735.00 for the purchase of textbooks to be furnished students in private schools.

Section 3. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following

sums for the purpose of closing construction accounts for the projects set forth:

- (a) Project 9002, Guam Memorial Hospital: \$6,112.66
- (b) Project 9039, Paseo de Susana Park: 1,606.95
- (c) Project 9138, Piti Playground Site: 1,431.43
- (d) Project 9139, Asan Playground Site: 485.81
- (e) Project 9143, Mangilao Playground Site: 2,232.45
- (f) Project 9151, Additional Facilities

for the Department of Agriculture: 270.23

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$50,000.00 for the Scholarship and Student Loan Fund.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$40,000.00 for the completion of construction, equipment and initial operation of the Vocational Education Trade School.

Section 6. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.

Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
