PUBLIC LAW 5-100 FIFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE 1960 (THIRD) Special Session G. L. 329 (3-S)

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR OPERATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1961, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the operation of the Office of the Governor and the Office of Budget and Management for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the Office of the Governor for the examination of the Executive Branch organization pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, As Amended.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the Office of the Governor to aid or assist in the prosecution of protests before the United States Maritime Commission, Washington, D. C., against an ocean freight rate increase from the continental United States to Guam in such manner and such amount as the Governor shall determine. The sum appropriated in this Section shall be used exclusively for the purpose mentioned herein, notwithstanding Section 5 of this Act.

Section 5. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed ten per cent (10%) of any item of appropriation, by this or any other Act, made for the operation of any department, agency or office of the Executive Branch operating under appropriated funds for the fiscal year 1961, to any

other item of appropriation, by this ar any other Act, for the operation of any department, agency or office of the Executive Branch operating under appropriated funds for the fiscal year 1961 with the exception of funds appropriated for allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote efficiency and economy of operation of the Executive Branch of the government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration of any function or program from one department to another of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of funds allocated to such function or program, notwithstanding the amount so transferred is in excess of ten per cent (10%) of the total amount appropriated for either such department.

Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.
