AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE RETIREMENT FUND, TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION EXPENSE OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, AND FOR THE OPERATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1961.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TENRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for the Executive Eranch's contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$275,000.00) for allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for operation of Boards and Commissions for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
