AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR RETAINING AN INDEPENDENT AUDIT FIRM TO AUDIT ALL FUNDS OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JUNE 30, 1960.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000,00) for the purpose of retaining an outside independent audit firm to conduct a limited audit of the accounts and financial transactions of all funds of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year which ended June 30, 1960. The conduct of the audit shall be under the general direction of the Governor and the Speaker of the Legislature, or their respective delegates. The audit contract shall be in writing and shall be signed by the Governor of Guam and the Speaker of the Legislature.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
