FIFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE 1960 (SECOND) Regular Session G. L. 335

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AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 31047 OF THE GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO BUILDING PERMIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 31047 of the Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 31047. Fees. (a) Before a building permit is issued a permit fee therefor shall be paid to the building official in accordance with the following schedule based upon valuation of the proposed work.

> (1) Where the valuation is twenty-five dollars(\$25.00) cr less, no fee shall be required.

(2) Where the valuation is more than twentyfive dollars .(\$25.00) but not over one hundred dollars
(\$100.00), the fee shall be one dollar (\$1.00).

(3) Where the valuation is more than one
 hundred dollars (\$100.00) but not over four hundred
 dollars (\$400.00), the fee shall be two dollars (\$2.00).

(4) Where the valuation is more than four
hundred dollars (\$400.00) but not over seven hundred
dollars (\$700.00), the fee shall be three dollars
(\$3.00).

(5) Where the valuation is more than seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) but not over one thousand dollars (\$1000.00), the fee shall be four dollars (\$4.00).

(7) For each additional one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) valuation or fraction thereof, over fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) and up to and including fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), the fee shall be one dollar (\$1.00).

(8) For each additional one thousand dollars
(\$1000.00) valuation or fraction thereof, exceeding
fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), the fee shall
be fifty cents (\$0.50).

(9) Fees for sign boards not attached to a building shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).

(b) Where work for which a permit is required by this title, is started or proceeded with prior to obtaining said permit, the fees above specified shall be doubled, but the payment of such double fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of this title in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed herein.

(c) Before plans and specifications are accepted for checking, a plan-checking fee, in addition to the building permit fee, shall be paid to the building official, which plan-checking fee shall only be applicable to a building or structure

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whose total valuation is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or over. The plan-checking fee shall be one-half of the building permit fee.

(d) The fee for the moving of any building or structure shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).

(e) The fee for the demolition of anybuilding or structure shall be four dollars (\$4.00).

(f) In the case of revocation of a permit or abandonment or discontinuance of a building project, the volume of the work actually completed shall be computed and any excess fee for the completed work shall be returned to the permit holder; except that all penalties which may have been imposed on the permit holder under the provisions and requirements of this title shall first be collected." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
