



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



Substitute bill by Committee on
Finance and Taxation

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE
MAINTENANCE OF THE GUAM CONGRESS
BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 1961.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the govern-
4 ment of Guam the sum of Twenty-Three Thousand Forty-Two Dollars
5 (\$23,042.00) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 for the maintenance
6 of the Guam Congress Building, including, but not limited to, wages
7 and salaries for janitors, janitorial and such other necessary supplies
8 and equipment, and utilities excluding telephone. The appropriation
9 herein made shall be administered in accordance with appropriate
10 Standing Rules of the Guam Legislature.

11 Section 2. The appropriation made by Public Law 5-96 for
12 the operation and contingent expenses of the Legislative Branch of
13 the government for fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 is hereby reduced
14 by Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$10,724.00).

15 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
