
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF
UNIFORMS FOR USE OF PERSONNEL WITH THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM, AND TO MAKE AN APPROPRIA-
TION THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4110.2 is hereby added to Chapter 2,
Title V, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 4110.2. Whenever employees of the
government of Guam are required to wear uniforms
in the performance of their duties, such uniforms
shall be furnished by the government upon request
of the department concerned, in accordance with
regulations of such department."

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the govern-
ment of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961, as a supplement
to the funds previously appropriated in Public Law 5-98, the sum of
Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) to the Department of Public
Safety.

Section 3. This act is an urgency measure.
