AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 7 TO TITLE XII OF THE GOVERNMENT COLE OF GUAR PERTAINING TO FREE TUITION FOR RESIDENTS OF GUAR TO THE COLLEGE OF GUAR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

IN IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. Chapter 7. Title XII. of the Government Code of Guam is hereby added to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 7

COLLEGE OF GUAN

Section 11600. Designation of College. The college founded and established by the Government of Guam heretofere designated as the Territorial College of Guam shall be known and designated as the College of Guem.

Section 11601. Management. The management of the College of Guam, for purposes of administration shall be in accordance with Section 11101 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 11602. Registration and Tuition. Tuition to the College of Guam shall be free to all residents of Guam. Registration fees and other charges shall be established by the Board of Education.

Registration fee and rate of tuition fixed by the Board of Education shall be required of each non-resident student. 'Non-resident student' means any person who has not been a bone fide resident of the territory of Guam for more than one (1) year immediately proceding the opening day of a semester during which he proposes to attend the College of Guam. Every alien student who has

not entered Guam as an immigrant or permanent resident with the intention of becoming a United States citizen as provided by law, prior to the opening day of a semester during which he proposes to attend the college is deemed to be a non-resident student.

Section 11603. Rules and Begulations as to Standards of Admission. The Board of Education in addition to the powers enumerated in Section 11101 of the Government Code of Guam shall adopt rules and regulations for the government of the College of Guam in prescribing (a) the standards of admission for students entering the college; and (b) the standardizing, as far as the Board doems wise and mecessary, of the courses of instruction offered in the college. Students shall be admitted to the College of Guam in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Board of Education pursuant to this section."

Section 2. This Act is an argoncy measure.
