

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4001 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE A FIVE-POINT CREDIT
BENEFIT TO THE FORMER EMPLOYEES OF THE GUAM
POLICE COMBAT PATROL IN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS
AND SELECTION FOR EMPLOYMENT WITHIN THE GOVERN-
MENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4001 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4001. General. The employment and promotion
5 of persons in the service of the government of Guam shall be
6 upon the basis of merit and fitness. Positions in the classi-
7 fied service as defined in Section 4002 of this chapter shall
8 be filled as far as practicable by competitive selection
9 methods. Preference in filling positions and all appointments
10 in the government of Guam shall be in accordance with Section
11 9(a) of Public Law 630, 81st Congress, otherwise referred to
12 as the Organic Act of Guam. Provided, also, that in competitive
13 examinations and selection for employment in the service of the
14 government of Guam, veterans of the Armed Forces of the United
15 States, who received honorable discharges therefrom or who
16 were released from active duty under honorable conditions and
17 who are residents of Guam, and former members of the Guam
18 Police Combat Patrol who served honorably therein and whose
19 service has been certified by the Director of Public Safety,
20 shall receive a preferential credit of five points which shall
21 be automatically added to their grade or score upon passing
22 the required examination in computing their status within
23 the competitive service."

24 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
