



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1158, CIVIL CODE  
OF GUAM, PERTAINING TO RECORDING OF  
INSTRUMENTS AND JUDGMENTS.**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1158 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1158. What may be recorded; Where.

5 Any instrument or judgment affecting the title to or possession  
6 of real property may be recorded under this chapter: Provided,  
7 however, that deeds or grants conveying to a governmental  
8 agency, real estate, or any interest therein, or easements  
9 thereon, for public purposes shall not be accepted for  
10 recordation without the consent of the grantee evidenced by its  
11 acceptance attached to such deed or grant. Instruments and  
12 judgments to be recorded pursuant to this section shall be  
13 recorded in the Department of Land Management."

14 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.

15 Section 3. This Act shall take effect as of July 1, 1960.
