AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTIONS 12149 AND 12150 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 12150 TO ARTICLE III, CHAPTER 2, TITLE XIII OF THE GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE SLAUGHTER OF CATTLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 12149 and 12150 of Article III, Chapter 2, Title XIII of the Government Code of Guam are hereby renumbered Sections 12155 and 12156, respectively, and a new Section 12150 is hereby added to said Article to read as follows:

6 "Section 12150. Cattle slaughtering for food 7 purposes: Notice. No person shall slaughter or kill any 8 cattle for food purposes unless he shall notify the 9 Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner of the respective 10 districts in Guam where the slaughtering occurs, within 11 twenty-four hours of such slaughtering." 12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
